

USPS Web Tools Migration Guide

Label and SCAN Form APIs

Version 1.1 (07/19/2024)



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1 Overview

USPS is taking steps with its API program to improve efficiency, strengthen security, and enhance customer experience. Label generation is a core service USPS offers to its customers; and, as part of our label integration strategy, USPS has deployed a new API platform (USPS APIs) and package validation system (USPS Ship). The legacy Web Tools platform and the electronic verification system (eVS) are being retired and customers must migrate to the new platforms or an approved third-party vendor. Once the new API platform is integrated into your website, the APIs communicate over HTTPS using JSON (JavaScript Object Notation) and OAuth 2.0 protocols for access authorization.



Note: eVS customers must migrate to USPS Ship as a prerequisite to migrating to new platform.

- Web Tools label API users must migrate to the USPS Label API by July 14th, 2024.

1.1 USPS Domestic Label API

The USPS Labels API allows you to digitally create shipping labels for the following mail classes: USPS Ground Advantage™, Parcel Select® Destination Entry, USPS Connect® Local, USPS Connect® Regional, USPS Connect® Same Day, USPS Connect® Next Day, Priority Mail®, Priority Mail Express®, Bound Printed Matter, Library Mail, Media Mail®, and USPS Return Services. The USPS Label API uses a token to authorize the use of an Enterprise Payment or Permit account. The specification to generate the token is in the payments API.

The following fields are used to assure that a label is generated:

- Account Type, specify the type of payment account, either EPS or PERMIT.
- Account Number, specify the account number for either the EPS or PERMIT account (e.g. permit number).
- Permit ZIP Code™, specify the permit ZIP Code™ for the PERMIT account. it is not required for an EPS account.

1.2 USPS International Label API

The USPS® International Labels API allows you to digitally create shipping labels for First Class Package International Service, Priority Mail International, Priority Mail Express International. You will need credentials necessary for the payment of labels. The following fields are used to assure that a label is generated:

- Account Type, specify the type of payment account, either EPS or PERMIT.
- Account Number, specify the account number for either the EPS or PERMIT account (e.g. permit number).
- Permit ZIP Code™, specify the permit ZIP Code™ for the PERMIT account. it is not required for an EPS account.

1.3 USPS SCAN Form API

Shipment Confirmation Acceptance Notice (SCAN) form allows integrators to link multiple domestic and international labels through one Electronic File Number (EFN) and physical SCAN Form (PS Form 5630). The USPS® scans this form at mailing acceptance to generate an acceptance tracking event for each linked label. The default media type of the response is multipart-mixed. The metadata part of the multipart response representation is only in application/json format media type, as default.

The following fields are used to assure that a label is generated:

- Account Type, specify the type of payment account, either EPS or PERMIT.
- Account Number, specify the account number for either the EPS or PERMIT account (e.g. permit number).
- Permit ZIP Code™, specify the permit ZIP Code™ for the PERMIT account. it is not required for an EPS account.

2 Customer Onboarding

Onboarding new API customers onto the USPS APIs platform requires the following steps below.



Note: If Web Tools customers are looking to transition over to the new USPS APIs platform, account information will not be automatically transferred/migrated over and will require sign up for USPS APIs.

1. The customer will create a new USPS Business Account by navigating to the [Customer Onboarding Platform](#) and filling out the below prompts.



Note: Your [Customer Onboarding Platform](#) (COP) account will link to BCG automatically during setup. If Web Tools customers already have COP and Enterprise Payment Account EPA setup then they can go directly to step 3.

2. Create a Username and Password.
3. Enter User Information.
4. Enter Company Information.
5. Verify the Company Address.
6. The Customer is assigned a CRID.
 - a. Setup payment details (EPS account).
 - b. Setup Developer access using your COP credentials on the [USPS APIs Developer Portal](#)
 - c. Create a new App.
 - d. Subscribe to a USPS API Product.
 - e. Link CRID/MID, Client credentials (Key/Secret) to the USPS APIs account.
 - f. Customers can then test one of the sample APIs provided within the API catalog on the Developer Portal to verify the account has been setup properly and they are getting successful API responses.



Note: The default “Shipping Default” API Product will allow customer to use only the following APIs: Address API, Service Standards API, Domestic Price API and International Price API. Please refer to [Appendix B](#) for sample API collection.

7. To access other APIs, API management team to approve a separate API Product request. To get the approval customer can reach out to apisupport@usps.gov.

The following onboarding process requires the steps below to continue using the USPS APIs platform.

2.1 Payment Setup (or EPS)

This is an optional step for a customer that has initially not had a payment method added into their account and want to update their payment account details in the Business Customer Gateway (BCG).

1. Sign up for an EPS or Payment method for your Business Customer Gateway account.
2. Once you login into your BCG account, on your dashboard below select “Manage Account” to add services like Payment.



Note: You can add as many services to your account as you would like.

3 Developer Access setup via Developers Portal

Go to <https://developer.usps.com> to finalize Developer access using your USPS.com Customer Onboarding credentials and linking all your client credentials and payment services to your account.

1. Navigate to the USPS API Developer Portal at <https://developer.usps.com>.
2. Use Customer Onboarding Platform log in credentials.



Note: While all documentation is available without logging into the Developer Portal, the login credentials are required to create an App for using USPS APIs.

3.1 Developer Portal and User Application Creation

Users with a USPS business account can use the Developer Portal to register Apps, generate OAuth tokens, and access all USPS APIs.

To create/register an App, the user must be logged into the USPS APIs Developer Portal. Below are the instructions:

1. Once logged in, select “Apps” in the menu bar.

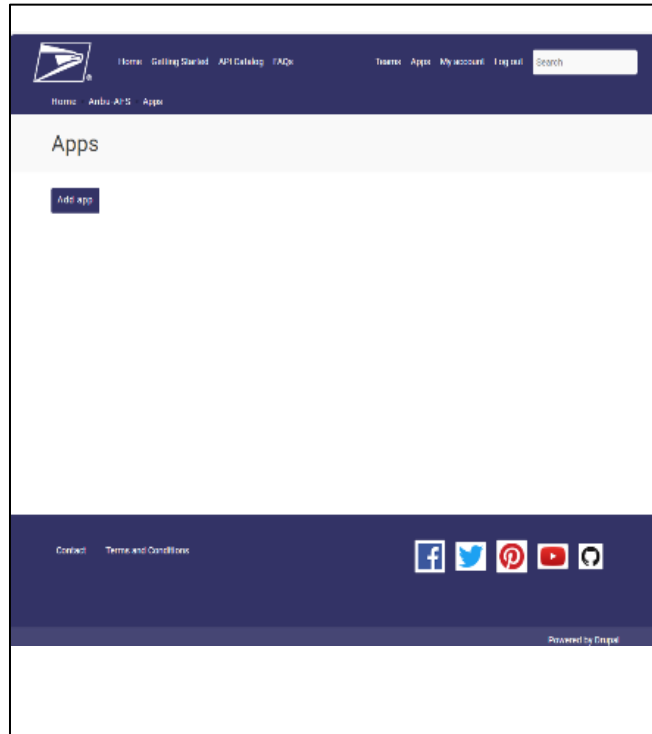


Figure 1: USPS Developer Portal Apps page

2. Click the "Add app" button.
3. Enter "App Name" for your application (required).
4. Enter "Callback URL" (optional).
5. Enter "Description" (optional).
6. Select the API Product available (required) – Example: “Shipping Version 3”.
7. Click "ADD APP" Button.

8. To access other APIs, please send a separate API Product request to the API management team to review and approve. To get the approval customer can reach out to apisupport@usps.gov.

3.2 Retrieve your Consumer Key and Secret

The Consumer Key and Secret are required credentials used when creating the OAuth token within the customer's software. The Consumer Key and Secret are what is used to gain access to the APIs.

Select the application you just registered and retrieve your Consumer Key and Consumer Secret from the credentials section. These credentials are required for generating the OAuth token.

1. After creating the platform App, the user must select/click the **Approved** button to view credentials.
2. Use the provided Consumer (Client) Key and Customer (Client) Secret to create the OAuth token.
3. The Consumer Key uniquely identifies the client App (Username), and the Consumer Secret (Password).

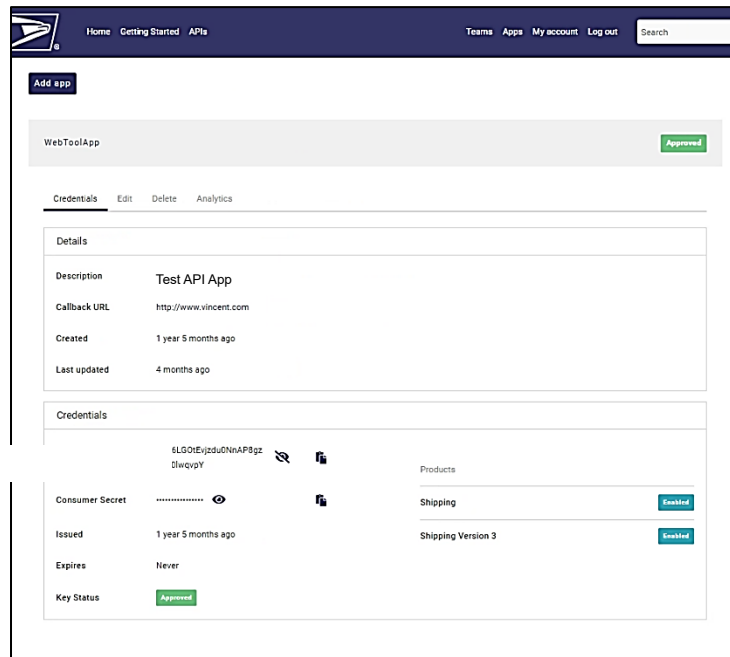


Figure 3: USPS Developer Portal Credentials page

4 Using USPS API Platform

The following steps below are for API Token, API Payment, and creating your labels in Production. If the customer wants to test the APIs, they can sign-up in CAT environment and may test label generation.

The below instructions focus on generating an OAuth Token and Payment Token for payment of both domestic and international labels. Postman is the software used to generate these tokens for demonstration purposes below.



Note: Any third-party software can be used to generate these tokens. **Postman is not mandatory.**

OAuth Token - International:

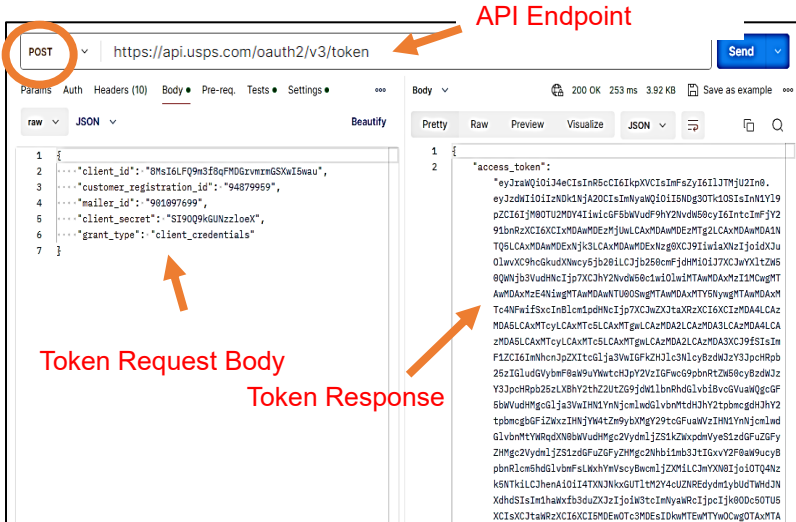


Figure 5: OAuth Token International

4.2 API Payment

A Payment Authorization token must be generated to call the Labels API. A token is a software key to authenticate the user against the API platform and authorize the user to call their approved APIs. Below are the instructions on how to generate a payment authorization token for domestic and international labels (See Section 2.1 on how add Enterprise Payment Service Account).

Note: The Parties input is required to generate this token. The PAYER and the LABEL_OWNER roles are required to pay for any label transaction.

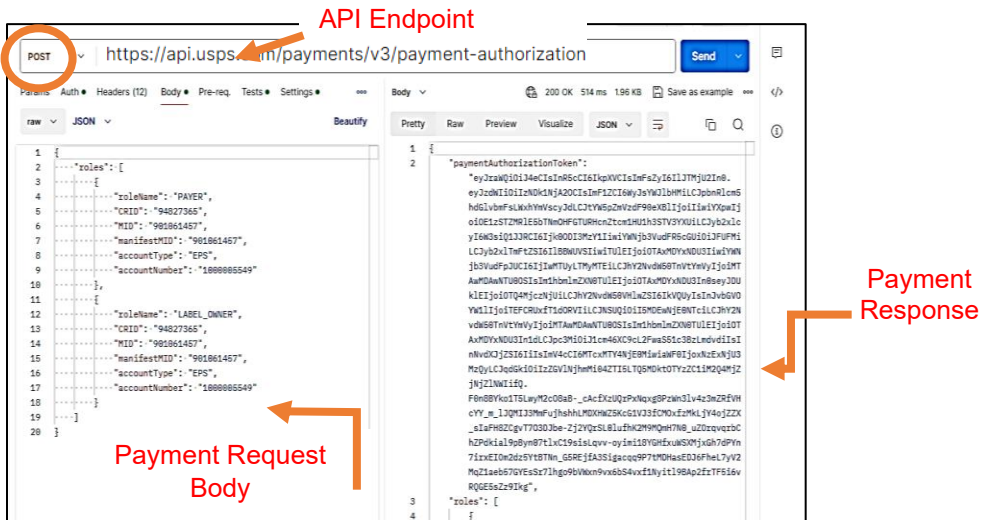


Figure 6: Domestic Payment API Example

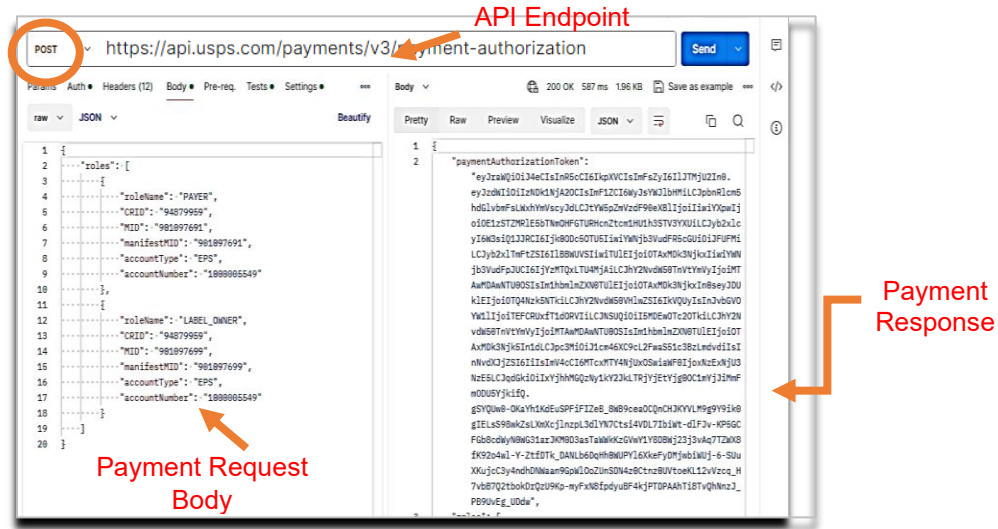



Figure 7: International Payment API Example

5 Creating your Labels and SCAN Forms

To obtain labels, a customer must be enrolled in USPS Ship. To generate labels, a customer must use the Labels API and have a valid payment method.

 **Note:** See Appendix A for USPS Ship instructions and Payment Set up section for instructions. See Appendix E for Label images and Scan forms.

1. To generate a label, transactions must be charged to Enterprise Payment Account (EPA)
2. The very first step to create a label is to get authenticated with the new API platform.
 - 2.1. Call OAuth Token request as given in Section 4.1 [API Token](#)
 - 2.2. Call Payment Authorization request as given in Section 4.2 [API Payment](#)
3. Once the Token and Payment authorization are done, then subsequent Label API requests will need authenticated/authorized token in Auth Header of the API request.
 (Example: 'Authorization: Bearer eyJraWQiOiJ1Ij5MmRGRGY3eDdFQkF.....')

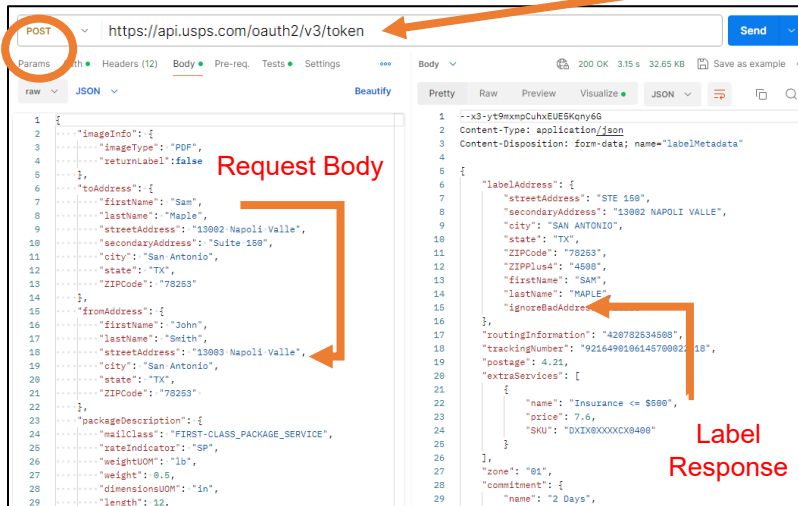



Figure 8: Domestic Label API Call Request Example

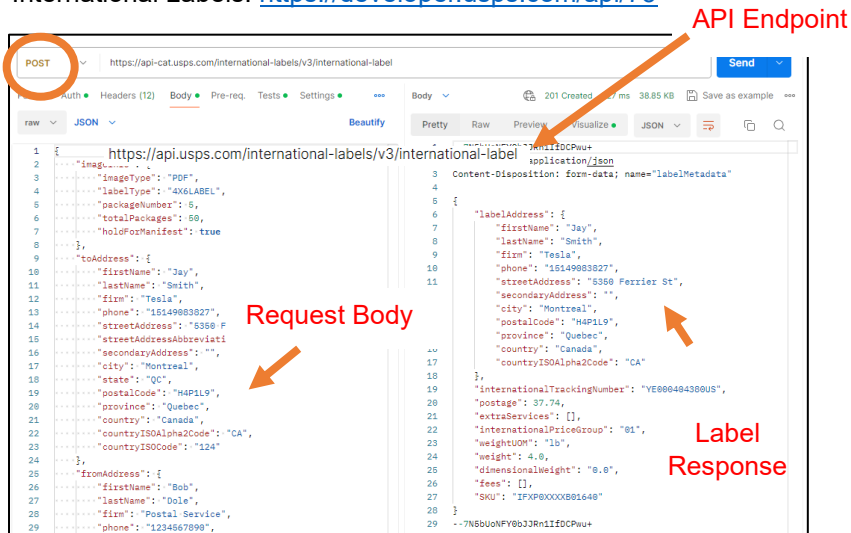


Figure 10: International SCAN Form API Call Request Example

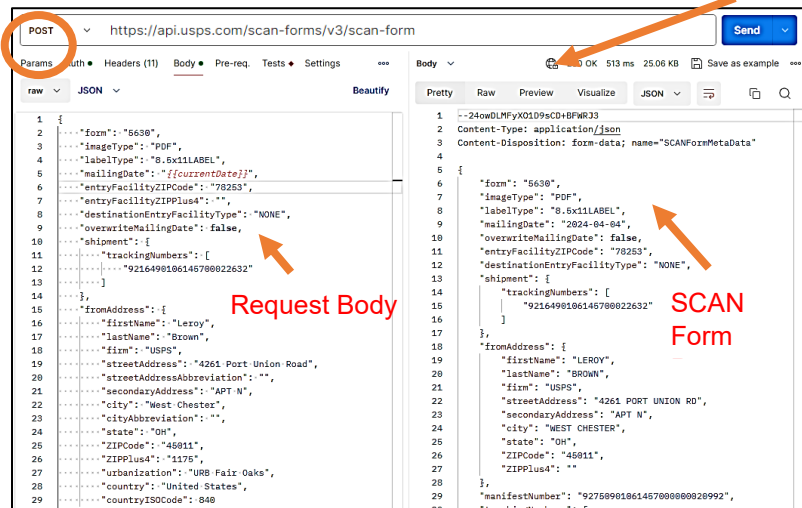


Figure 11: SCAN Form API Call Request Example

Existing shippers must migrate from eVS to USPS Ship with their existing customer profiles. eVS shippers must consider all their existing credentials (Mailer IDs, Enterprise Payment Accounts, Permits, Contract/Customized Pricing) for the migration.

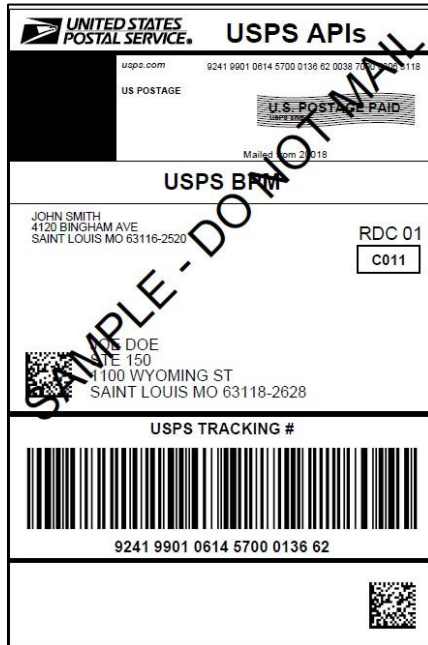


Figure 14: USPS BPM Label Sample

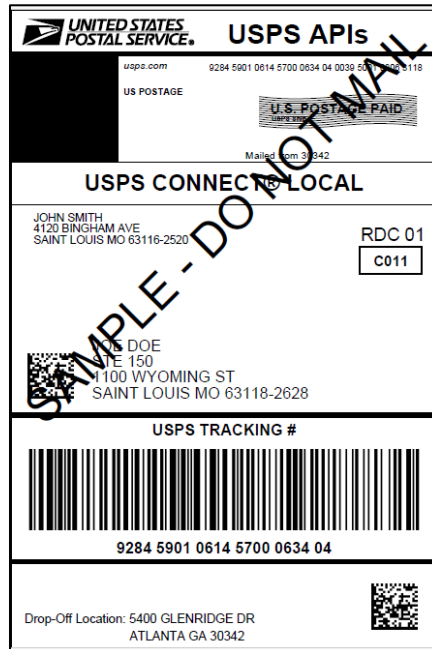


Figure 15: USPS Connect Local Label Sample

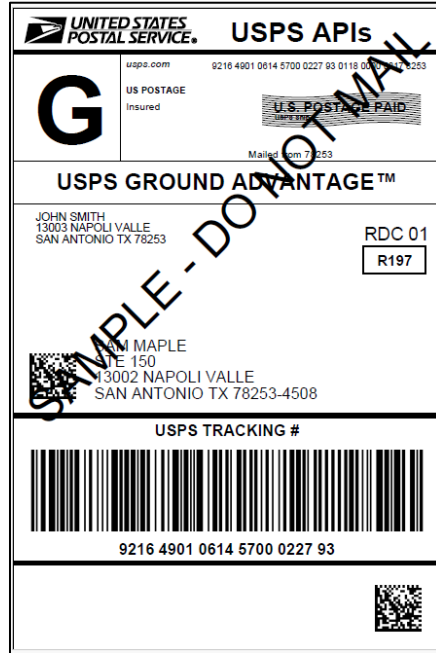


Figure 16: USPS Ground Advantage Sample Label

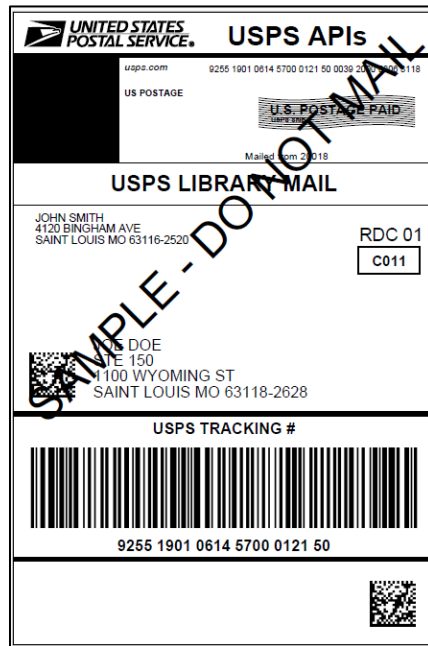


Figure 17: USPS Library Mail Label Sample

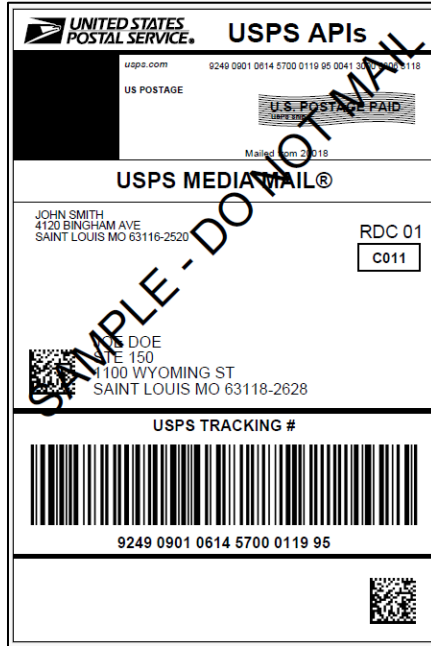


Figure 18: USPS Media Mail Label Sample

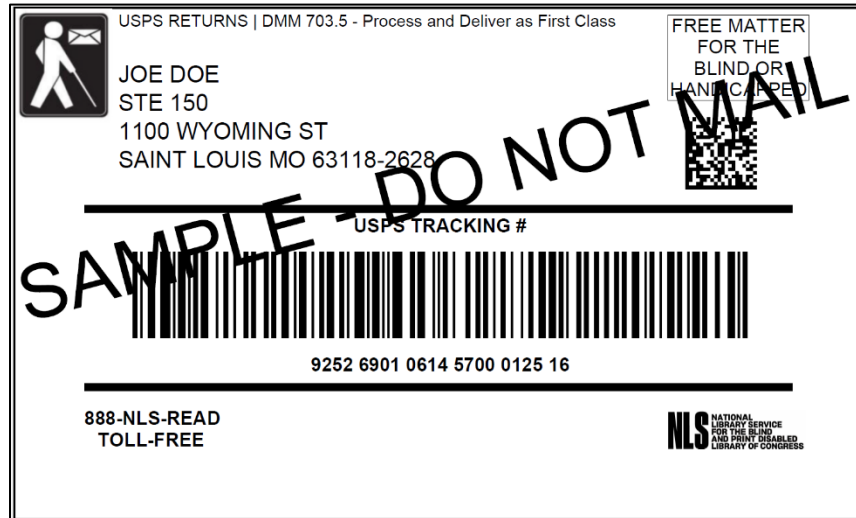


Figure 25: USPS Domestic Free Matter for the Blind Return Label Sample
